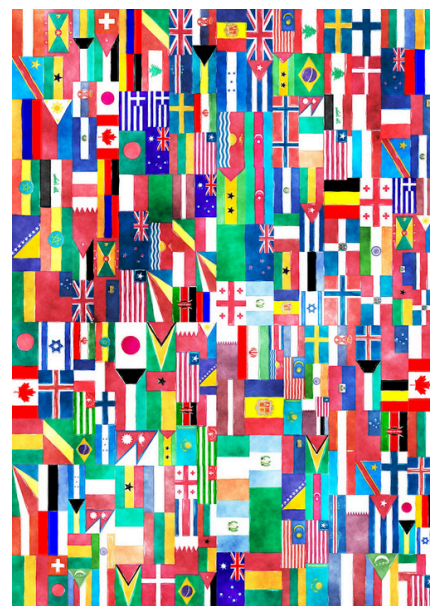
MAY HALF TERM
